

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

SEALED BID PROPOSAL NO. 18-001

The City of Harahan will receive sealed bids on a General Contract for City of Harahan Emergency Sewer Repairs – Improvements to Sewer Lift Station No. 8, complete with all necessary appurtenances. The work to be performed under the General Contract for City of Harahan Emergency Sewer Repairs consists of the repair and rehabilitation of the existing Sewer Lift Station No. 8 as well as the existing roadway. The City of Harahan will receive bids until 10:00 a.m. on **Wednesday, January 31st, 2018** at the City of Harahan City Hall, 6437 Jefferson Hwy, Harahan, LA. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. All interested parties are invited to attend. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at 10:00 a.m. in the aforementioned location.

The General Contract for City of Harahan Emergency Sewer Repairs consists generally of the removal and replacement of damaged pipe fittings within the existing Sewer Lift Station No. 8 and by-pass pumping during the lift station rehabilitation. It also consists of roadway rehabilitation with portland cement and asphalt concrete pavement. There will be work performed by the City of Harahan simultaneously with the Contractor within the limits of construction. This work shall be coordinated by the Contractor. The Contractor shall be required to follow the construction sequencing described in the Drawings (Sheet 002 – Note 20) as well as Specifications (Section 01010 – Summary of Work – Paragraph 1.05).

There will be a **Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting** held on the project site at 10:00am on **Wednesday, January 17th, 2018**. The project location is at the corner of 9th Street and Grove Avenue in Harahan, LA. Bids submitted by entities that did not attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting shall be considered non-responsive and that entities bid will not be opened.

Bidders shall provide a bid in accordance with the Bid Form included in the Contract Documents. Segregated Bids will not be accepted.

No oral interpretation will be made to any Bidder as to the meaning of the drawings, specifications, or contract documents. Every request for such interpretation shall be made in writing and addressed and forwarded to the Engineer, Architect or person distributing plans and specifications. No inquiry received within five (5) business days prior to the day fixed for opening of the bids will be given consideration.

Each Bid must be accompanied by certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond acceptable to the owner in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount bid, and payable without condition to the owner.

A complete set of Contract Documents may be secured from AIMS Group, Inc., 4421 Zenith Street, Metairie, LA 70001 (PHONE 504-887-7045, FAX 504-887-7088) by licensed contractors upon receipt of **\$125.00 per set**. Deposit on the first set of documents furnished bona fide prime bidders will be fully refunded upon return of documents in good condition no later than ten (10) days after receipts of bids.

Contract, if awarded, will be to a Bidder licensed under the provisions of the Contractors Licensing Law of the State of Louisiana. Bids shall remain binding for at least forty-five (45) days after the date set for Bid Opening. In the event the Owner issues the Letter of Award during this period, the bid accepted shall continue to remain binding until the Execution of Contract. Bidder expressly agreeing to the extension of the deadline for award provided in LSA R.S. 38:2215.

Surety companies providing bonding shall be licensed to do business in Louisiana.

The Contractor is responsible for equipment and material delivery dates. A time extension to the contract duration will not be allowed for late material or equipment delivery and liquidated damages will be assessed if the contract extends beyond the contract period.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive technicalities and informalities, as permitted by public bid law, La R.S.38:2212 et seq.
